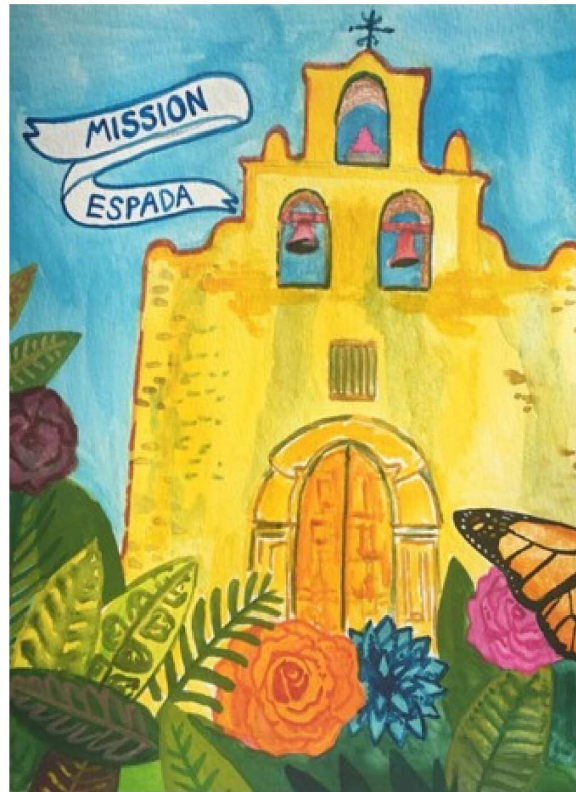
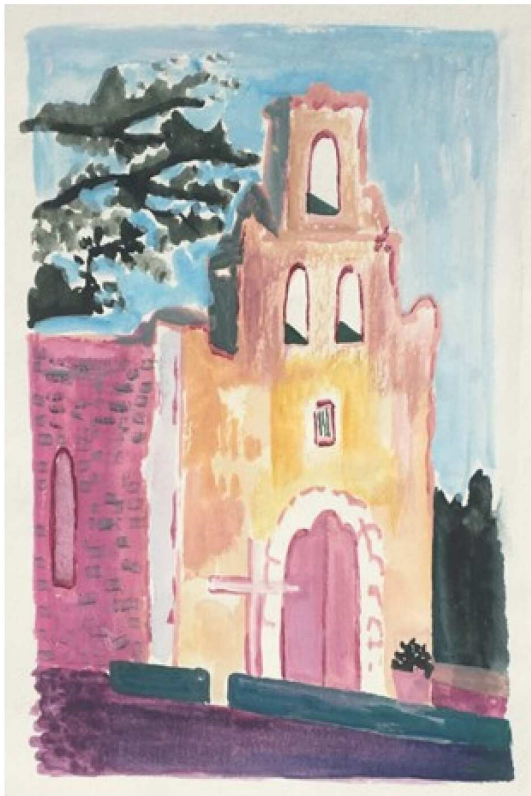
Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament

“Pray the Lord of the harvest to send laborers into his harvest.”

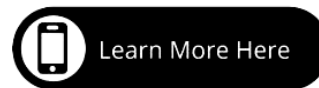

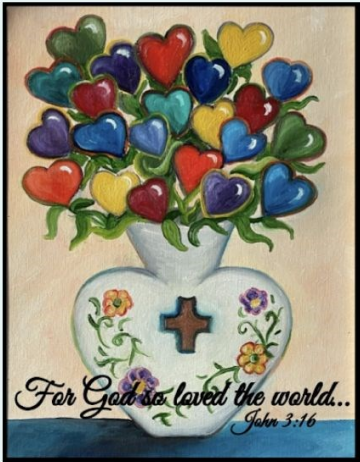
