## Liturgy of the Eucharist

The Liturgy of the Eucharist is the highpoint of the Mass. It's also the summit of our entire faith and worship. There is no more perfect way to worship God than to enter into the celebration of the Eucharistic Sacrifice, adore His divine presence and receive Him in Holy Communion.

#### THE RITE OF HOLY COMMUNION:

The Rite of Holy Communion encompasses all the prayers and actions that immediately prepare us to receive this precious gift. These include: 1) The Our Father; 2) The Sign of Peace; 3) The Fractioning; 4) The "Beholding;" 5) Holy Communion; 6) The Communion antiphon; 7) The Closing Prayer; 8) The Blessing. Let's look at each of these actions in more detail.

1.) Our Father: The "Our Father" prayer establishes the fact that, because of our "Communion" with Jesus, we are also children of the Father. We are brothers and sisters of Christ and, therefore, also children of His Father. This prayer also reveals and professes our continual entering into a deeper intimacy with the Father through Communion with Jesus.
