Catholics are required to fast and abstain on certain days during Lent, in imitation of Jesus' fast in the desert.



"Fasting" is defined as eating one regular-sized meal and two small meals. "Abstaining" means refraining from eating animal flesh. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of Fast and Abstinence. All Fridays of Lent are days of Abstinence.


