Dear Parishioners,

Shalom!

I hope and pray this message finds you in good health and spirits.

As we announced at all Masses last weekend, we will be holding a second collection this weekend to support the victims of the flooding in San Antonio and Central Texas. In the spirit of last Sunday's Gospel, let us extend our hands to our neighbors in need.

A heartfelt message from the Archdiocese of San Antonio reads: In Kerrville, Texas, a mother clutches her child in a borrowed sleeping bag inside a makeshift church shelter. Her home, her job, her car—gone in the flood. Her tears are echoed by hundreds of families in Kerrville, Ingram, Hunt, and beyond. What do we say to such heartbreak? We say: You are not forgotten. You are not alone.

"Carry each other's burdens, and in this way you will fulfil the Law of Christ." — Galatians 6:2

The affected families need our help now and in the months to come. From day one, Catholic Charities of San Antonio has been on the ground, delivering bottled water, hygiene kits, blankets, and emergency supplies. Our parish outreach fund has already contributed \$2,000 to Catholic Charities, but they require additional financial support for relief services and rehabilitation efforts.

The proceeds from this collection will be sent to the Archdiocese, where they will be administered by Catholic Charities.

I join Archbishop Gustavo, Bishop Mike, and Bishop Gary in expressing gratitude for your kindness towards our distressed brothers and sisters. Thank you for your generosity.
