



## She Shall Be Called Woman

This week's session may be the most powerful testimony in our entire program to date! Join us to discover the unending mercy of the Lord and His desire for His Bride to know she is truly forgiven and loved. We look forward to seeing you!

Besides being cured, what do Nathan (first reading) and the leper who thanked Jesus (Gospel) have in common? Both of them began to believe. Nathan proclaims Israel's God to be the only God. The only leper who returned to thank Jesus was "glorifying God in a loud voice" (Luke 17:15). It makes me wonder, what miracles do we see that help us grow in faith?

For an answer, we can look at a second thing they had in common: they both asked for help. Sometimes we get caught up in self-sufficiency mode, thinking we have to handle all our problems by ourselves. We may miss out on ways to solve those problems by not asking for help. If you think asking for help is a sign of weakness, you may be missing a chance for God to act through one of your friends and give you support. And, of course, you can ask God for help in prayer.

We may have friends who help us in times of need or inspire us with their faith, but we have to decide to make a leap of faith ourselves. The third thing that Nathan and the leper did in common was express their faith. You can spend your whole life thinking that you are a Christian, but if you never express that faith, it will be just a theory. St. Paul in the second reading, for example, was suffering in prison, but he didn't mind because his suffering demonstrated the importance of Jesus' message to him. So he wrote from prison in the hope that other Christians would be encouraged in their faith. Perhaps you know of someone who inspired you with their faithfulness and dedication. Having a friend who helps us grow in faith can be a very nice miracle indeed.

## Feast Day of St. Carlo Acutis



### WHO WAS CARLO ACUTIS?

Carlo Acutis was a Catholic teenager born in 1991 in London and raised in Milan. From a young age, he showed a deep love for the Eucharist, daily Mass, and the Rosary. He was also a talented computer programmer who used his skills to evangelize online.

### WHAT IS HE KNOWN FOR?

Carlo created a website and a traveling exhibit that cataloged 187 Eucharistic miracles from around the world. He believed the Eucharist was “the highway to heaven” and inspired many to grow in devotion to Jesus.

### WHEN IS HE BEING CANONIZED?

Carlo Acutis will be canonized Sept. 7, 2025, becoming the first millennial saint. Pope Francis approved the second miracle needed for sainthood in 2023.

### WHAT MIRACLES ARE ATTRIBUTED TO HIS INTERCESSION?

#### Mattheus Vianna:

A Brazilian boy with a rare pancreatic disorder was miraculously healed after prayers to Carlo.

#### Valeria Valverde:

A Costa Rican teen miraculously recovered from a near-fatal brain injury after her mother visited Carlo’s tomb and prayed for his intercession.

### WHAT DID POPE FRANCIS SAY?

“His witness shows today’s young people that true happiness is found by putting God first and serving him in our brothers, especially the least.” —Pope Francis, October 11, 2020.

### WHAT CAN WE LEARN FROM HIS LIFE?

Carlo challenges us to live with purpose and holiness. He once said, “I’m happy to die because I lived my life without wasting even a minute on things unpleasing to God.” His joyful faith reminds us that sanctity is possible in the modern world.
