



PEOPLE, PERSISTENCE AND PRAYER

In today's Gospel from Luke Jesus tells a parable to remind us to

"PRAY ALWAYS WITHOUT BECOMING WEARY."

The story can be a bit confusing. Is God like the judge who finally answers the widow because she kept asking for a verdict? The judge sounds annoyed with the widow. Does this mean our constant praying annoys God? Not at all! This is another parable where Jesus points out how different God is from human beings. He uses an extreme example to get our attention.

WHAT CAN WE CONSIDER FROM THIS PARABLE?



In the end, the most important thing we can do is turn to God before we act. It can be as simple as taking a breath and inviting the Holy Spirit to enlighten you before you respond. Other days, you may spend an hour praying with Scripture or praying the rosary with others. The people we spend time with, our level of persistence and our prayer life are going to shift and change as our life does, but I invite you to do your best to put God first throughout the day in different ways. He is always paying attention.






