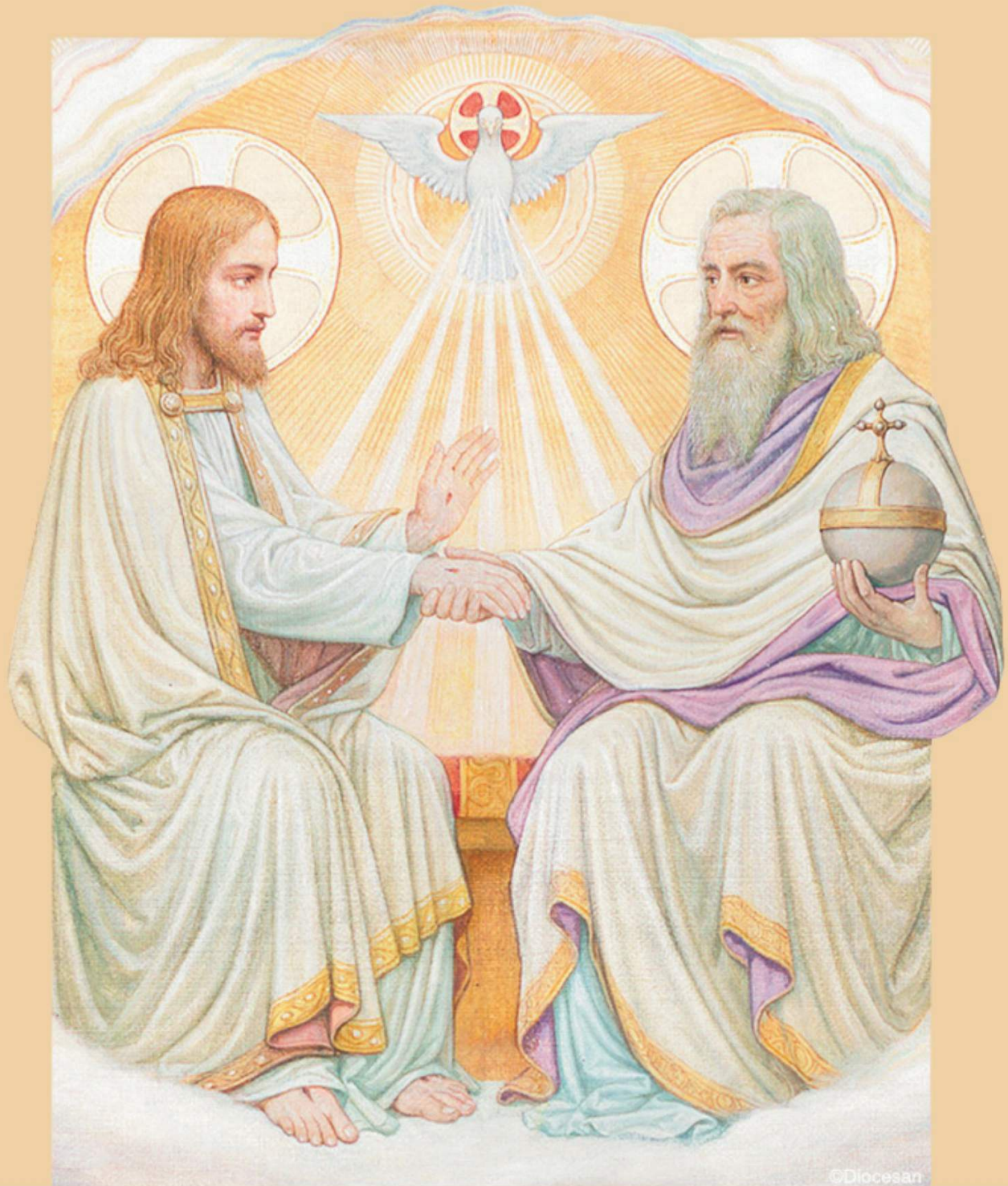



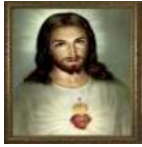

CONSECRATION OF THE UNITED STATES TO THE SACRED HEART

Dear Parishioners,

As many of you know, our nation will celebrate a historic milestone this year — the **250th Anniversary of the signing of the Declaration of Independence on July 4th**. To mark this special occasion, the bishops of the United States have chosen a beautiful and deeply spiritual way to celebrate: **the consecration of our country to the Sacred Heart of Jesus on July 11, 2026**.

Consecration is “an act by which a person or thing is dedicated to the service and worship of God.” As individuals, Catholics and as a parish don’t we want to be part of this Kairos moment? Why consecrate the United States to the Sacred Heart of Jesus? Most Rev. Alexander K. Sample, Archbishop of Portland, explains why the bishops are consecrating the nation in a video, which you can see [here](#).

As a parish family, I would like to invite all of us to prepare spiritually for this important moment by joining the **Novena to the Sacred Heart**, beginning **June 3rd through June 11th**. We will pray the novena together at the end of each Mass before the final blessing.

I understand that, for practical reasons, many of you may not be able to attend Mass every day. I encourage you to pray this novena at home and follow the consecration of the United States to the Sacred Heart of Jesus online praying this Novena. Please make an effort to join us for the special Mass on **June 12 at 5:30 PM**, The Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. (This Mass will be in addition to our regular morning Mass.)

I have two more recommendations: **First**, make an hour of Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. How wonderful it is that we have perpetual adoration from Tuesday morning until Friday morning! The Adoration must be accompanied by at least one work of mercy. You can find a [guide here](#), with instructions for how to report your contribution as well as suggested works of mercy, suggested prayer intentions, links for local service organizations, and other resources.

Second, please bring the age-old tradition of placing the image of the Sacred Heart in your home – perhaps your living room or family gathering place – where it can be visible reminder of Christ’s merciful presence. This beautiful custom goes back to the 1600 and St. Margeret Mary Alacoque’s visions. Jesus himself asked her to do it and told her about the blessings it brings. The USCCB offers this [guide](#) to bring this beautiful practice into your home.

Let us take part in this great Consecration and be a blessing for others. Please discuss in your family as how best we can give a Catholic focus to this unique milestone of the country. Let us set not only our parish but the entire country on fire.
